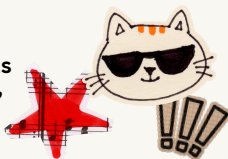

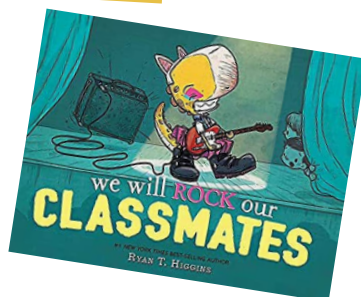
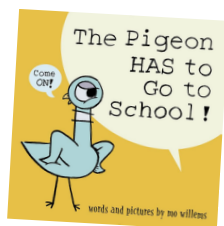

MILESTONES MATTER

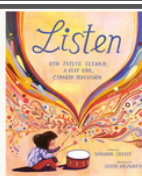
For ages 5 and under.
